- Provide education support and clinical advice for the Diabetes, Addictions and Suicide Prevention programs, including to GHCS partners such as social services, the school, the police etc.
- Participate in meetings of Suicide Prevention Team.
- > Participate in the mental health prevention and promotion activities of GHCS.
